About Keynote Speaker Kevin Sabet

Author, consultant, assistant professor and advisor to three U.S. presidential administrations, Kevin A. Sabet, Ph.D., has studied, researched, written about, and implemented drug policy for almost 20 years.

Author of *Reefer Sanity: Seven Great Myths About Marijuana*, he has been featured on the front page of the *New York Times* and in virtually every major media publication and news channel on the subject of drug policy.

Dr. Sabet is the Director of the Drug Policy Institute at the University of Florida and an Assistant Professor in the College of Medicine, Department of Psychiatry. With Patrick J. Kennedy, he is the co-founder of Project SAM (Smart Approaches to Marijuana) and is also a policy consultant to numerous domestic and international organizations.

Dr. Sabet's blog is housed at the *Huffington Post* and he is the winner of the 2014 *Nils Bejerot Award for Global Drug Prevention* and the *John P. McGovern Award for Drug Prevention*.

He received his Doctorate of Philosophy and Masters of Science from Oxford University as a Marshall Scholar in 2007 and 2002, respectively, and his B.A. with high honors in Political Science from the University of California, Berkeley in 2001.
